

Youth Ministry Summer Internship, First Baptist Church, Davis CA

June – August 2017 (start/end date is flexible)

Purpose of Internship

The Youth Ministry Summer Internship at FBC is designed to give guided hands-on training to young women and men who are growing to be leaders in the church. The intern will be led by the youth pastor so that he/she can do the following:

1. Gain practical ministry experience.
2. Receive guided education and training in youth ministry, church leadership, and personal spiritual growth.
3. Bring their gifts and creativity to the youth ministry.
4. Work in an atmosphere of personal and professional guidance and support.

Specific Ministry Responsibilities

1. Coordinate and lead Sunday morning youth group.
2. Coordinate and lead Monday night events.
3. Do prep work for our Back To School Bash and September Events.
4. Meet with groups of students midweek to encourage them as they follow Jesus.

Specific Ministry Training

The internship is a 29-hour-per-week position. Training will take place in these ways:

1. Regular meetings with the youth pastor to plan and evaluate the youth ministry.
2. Hands on ministry experience. The intern will gain experience leading in large group settings and will develop in the following areas:

- Teaching
- Outreach
- Leading volunteers
- Personal spiritual growth
- Pastoral care and spiritual formation
- Planning and running youth programs
- Ministry administration

3. Guided book study:

4. FBC will pay the registration fee for the intern to attend the Global Leadership Summit August 10-11 at FBC (FBC is a host site for the Summit).

2. Love for God, for the church, and for teens.
3. Able to work alone and with people, disciplined, motivated.
