The Internship Program at FBC is designed to develop women and men who are interested in pursuing vocational youth ministry. Interns will:

1. Gain significant ministry experience
2. Receive guided education and training in youth ministry
3. Bring gifts, creativity, and service to the youth ministry
4. Clarify vocational goals and prepare for how God will lead next
5. Work in an atmosphere of personal and professional guidance and support

Specific Ministry Training

We offer part-time or full-time internships

Training will take place in these ways:

1. Weekly meetings with the youth pastor to plan, discuss, and evaluate our youth ministry
2. Three guided book studies
3. One meeting with each of the FBC staff, and mentorship with someone from FBC
4. Hands on training and ministry experience in the following areas:

Part-time Interns receive \$12/hr for 20 hours per week.

Full-time Interns receive \$12/hr for 20 hours per week, and will fundraise for the rest of their financial support. FBC will match funds up to \$6000 and also provide support raising strategies.
