Purpose and Structure of Proverbs

Proverbs on Marriage

*It is better to live in a corner of the housetop
than in a house shared with a quarrelsome wife. – Proverbs 21:9*

*As charcoal to hot embers and wood to fire,
so is a quarrelsome man for kindling strife. – Proverbs 26.21*
