TRIVIA // Although Annapurna in Nepal is only the tenth tallest mountain in the world, it ranks as one of the most dangerous. Since the French climbers Maurice Herzog and Louis Lachenal summited on June 3, 1950, only 189 people have successfully made it to the top. Herzog's account of the climb, *Annapurna: The First Conquest Of An 8,000-Meter Peak*, is considered a classic of mountaineering literature and the most influential climbing book ever written.
