The Truth... about our future.

In my Father's house are many rooms. If it were not so, would I have told you that I go to prepare a place for you? And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and will take you to myself, that where I am you may be also. (v. 2-3)

prepare (hetoimazo) -

The Life... that Jesus brings.

If you had known me, you would have known my Father also. From now on you do know him and have seen him. (v. 7)

...this is eternal life, that they know you, the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom you have sent. John 17:3
